

Transgressing, linking and traversing via skateboarding in Palestine


A residency in the DeadSea, Palestine, with <http://eternalinternetbrotherhood.tumblr.com>

Using a skateboard, I surfed concrete between local Palestinian artists and Eternal Internet Brotherhood artists, that came to the Dead sea, for collecting works and ideas which then were placed in Pop up digital galleries. These galleries, offer a way to transgress borders between artists and the politics of the area. Hence, for example, allowing a Palestinian artist to have a show in a space they can not actually enter physically.

CommunityBoxes are small and localised PopUp internet hubs. They offer sharing data/information Only within a specific physical location.

In the Eternal Internet Brotherhood Dead-Sea instance, we exchanged artistic data/digital materials via community boxes between artists in Palestine and residents of the Eternal Internet Brotherhood. These exchanges are only located in the physical area, allowing future visitors in the area to experience the art materials they store/archive.
